



Coronavirus Home Test Kit




If you or someone you live with becomes poorly you might need to do a Coronavirus test at home.



Wash your hands for **20 seconds** before you begin.


The home testing kit has

- a cotton bud that is called a swab.
- a small tube.
- a small plastic envelope.
- a large plastic envelope.




Look in a mirror, open your **mouth**, and stick out your **tongue**.

Wipe the soft tip of the swab around the back of your throat for 10 seconds.



Put the **swab** inside of your **nostril** and gently wipe around the inside of your **nose**.


Do this again in the other nostril.



Step 1.


Put the soft **end of the swab** into the **small tube**.

Break the **plastic end off** so that the swab part stays in the **small tube** and throw the stick away.



Step 2.

Put the lid on the small tube and put it into the **small plastic envelope** and seal.



Step 3.

Put the **small plastic envelope** in the **large plastic envelope** and seal.

Hand the plastic envelope back.



Wash your hands again.
